I Can Use Commas in Dates

»»»Rules«««

Always place a comma between the day of the month and the year.

 Also, place a comma after the year, when writing a date within a sentence. August 2, 2015

On August 2, 2015, Henry celebrated his birthday.



»»»Rules«««

- Always place a comma after a dialogue word.
- Always place a comma after the quotation, but before the final set of quotation marks, when the quotation is before the speaker and would end in a period.

Jenny stated, "Today is a great day."

"Today is a great day," Jenny stated.

I Can Use Commas in Friendly Letters

»»»Rules«««

 Always place a comma after the greeting in a friendly letter.

 Always place a comma after the closing in any type of letter. Dear Jane,

Sincerely, Mr. Woods


Always place a comma between the name of a city or town and its state, district, or country.

I Can Use Commas in Compound Sentences


»»»Rule««« Always use commas before coordinating conjunctions in compound sentences.




I Can Use Commas when Directly Quoting from a Text






