A comma is placed between the name of a city or town and its state, district, or country.

## I Can Use Commas

## in Dates

## »»»Rules《<<<

Always place a comma between the day of the month and the year.

- Also, place a comma after the year, when writing a date within a sentence.


## I Can Use Commas

## in Dialogue

## »»»Rules《<<<

- Always place a comma after a dialogue word.
- Always place a comma after the quotation, but before the final set of quotation marks, when the quotation is before the speaker and would end in a period.


## Jenny stated, "Today is a great day."

"Today is a great day," Jenny stated.

- Always place a comma

 after the greeting in a friendly letter.- Always place a comma after the closing in any type of letter.
