

# CARE AND DISCIPLINE POLICY.



To maintain a positive classroom the children will need to show

- Courtesy
- Co-operation
- Consideration
- Organisation
- Respect
- Initiative

All of the above are discussed with the children.

## **IN CLASS BEHAVIOUR**

**The children will be asked to**

- Display respect, kindness and manners to both peers and adult.
- Follow instruction promptly
- Help each other out
- Help with classroom tasks
- Take care of property
- Organise and be responsible for their belongings
- Use recess and lunch breaks for toilet visits wherever possible
- Accept differences in classmates

## REWARDS

- Verbal praise for a job well done
- Constant encouragement of positive behaviours
- Stamps, stickers, certificates for particular achievements
- Recognition by Principal or Deputy Principal
- **Class Dojo**
- **Whole class rewards** are gained by earning 1000 Dojo Points\_(Popcorn and movie afternoon)
- **Individual Rewards** if a child reaches 20 Dojo points in one week they will receive a reward. See individual rewards page.
- Parents will be informed through Class Dojo if their child has had a really great day or has done something that is outstanding.

## CONSEQUENCES

Class Dojo - Parents will be able to see daily how their child has behaved at school. If a child receives 3 negative Dojos in one day an email through Dojo will be sent home to inform parents. The child will be required to spend 15minutes in another class and fill in a "Think Sheet." If a child goes to another class three times their parents will be contacted and a meeting set up to discuss the child's behaviour.

## FAST TRACK

For a severe breach of appropriate behaviour the school wide Red Card system is used. When the card is used the child is immediately removed from the classroom and Administration take control.
