

3 different activities to help students practice inferring using task cards!

Inference Task Cards Games!

Three different Games to Play Using your 24 Task Cards:

Scoot: Place one task card on each student desk. Then, give each student a recording sheet and a pencil and let them scoot around the room! Each student completes the card on their desk first and writes their answer in the number on their recording sheet that corresponds to the number on the task card. You can let students "Scoot" freely or have them all scoot at the same time. Answer Key included.

Bug Out (2-3 players) Add in the additional "Bug Out" cards to your task cards. Players take turn picking task cards, reading them aloud and answering question. Students keep the cards they answer correctly. If a "Bug Out" card is pulled, student must put all their cards in the "Trash" pile. After all cards have been pulled, whoever has the most task cards left in their pile wins!

Fly Trap (2 & 3 person game boards included)
Students must answer task cards to move forward.
First one to the finish wins. Watch out for "Fly
Trap" cards though, you don't want to lose a turn!


